Lot's going on in the Town. We are looking to do a dedication after the finishing touches are completed on the new basketball courts. 
<u>News from the Clerk's Office</u>

Reminder that you must have a compost permit in order to take leaves, brush or branches to the compost facility.

The facility has video surveillance to prevent illegal dumping

- You MUST be a town resident
- NO CONTRACTORS
- If you hire a lawn person the amount you pay them is for disposal also they CAN NOT take it to the facility
- If a neighbor/relative helps you must accompany them as the permit is in your name
