

DOG LICENSES



All dogs four months of age or older in the Town must be licensed. At the time of the original application, a certificate of altering must be presented if the dog has been spayed or neutered. Proof of current rabies vaccination is also required. Such proof will need to be supplied at each expiration date. The license is valid for one year. The clerk's office sends out a renewal notice prior to the expiration date. The fee for a spayed or neutered dog is \$8.50. An unaltered dog fee is \$16.50. Fees are payable by cash, check or money order. All licensing must be done in person at the town hall.

The City of Elmira provides dog control services for the Town of Elmira. For immediate assistance or emergencies with dog control you should call 735-8600.
