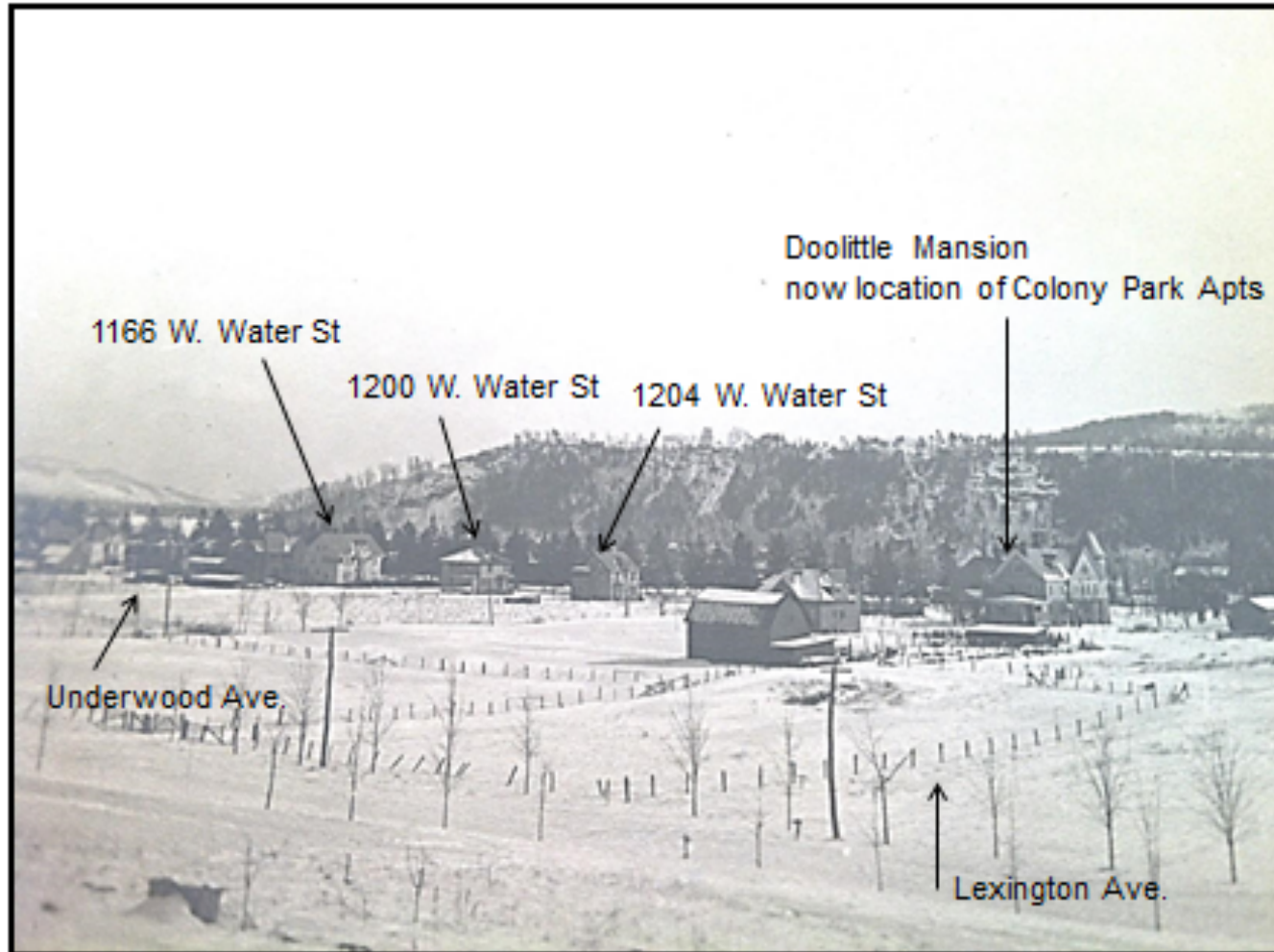


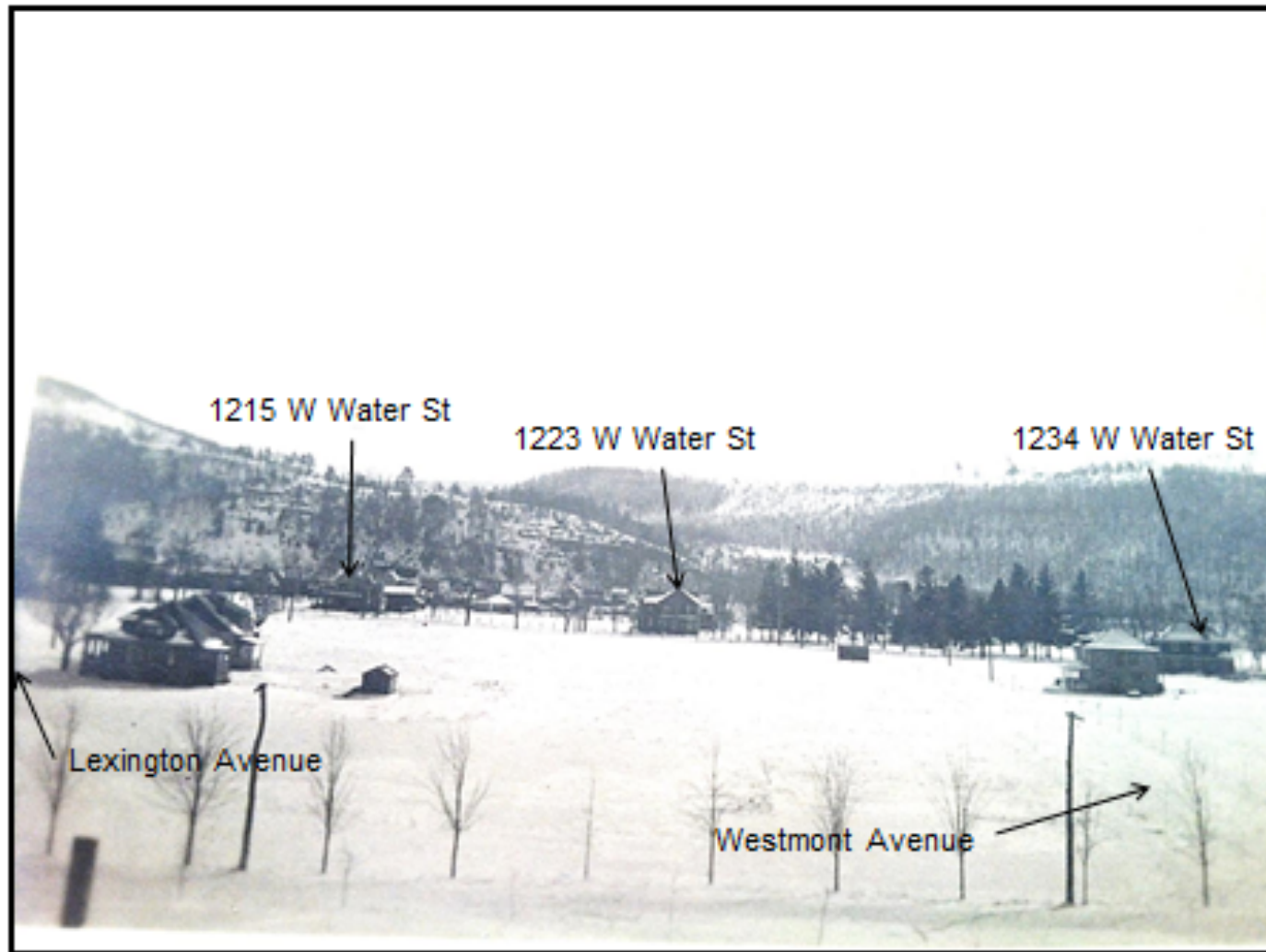
Photos from 1915 of West Elmira

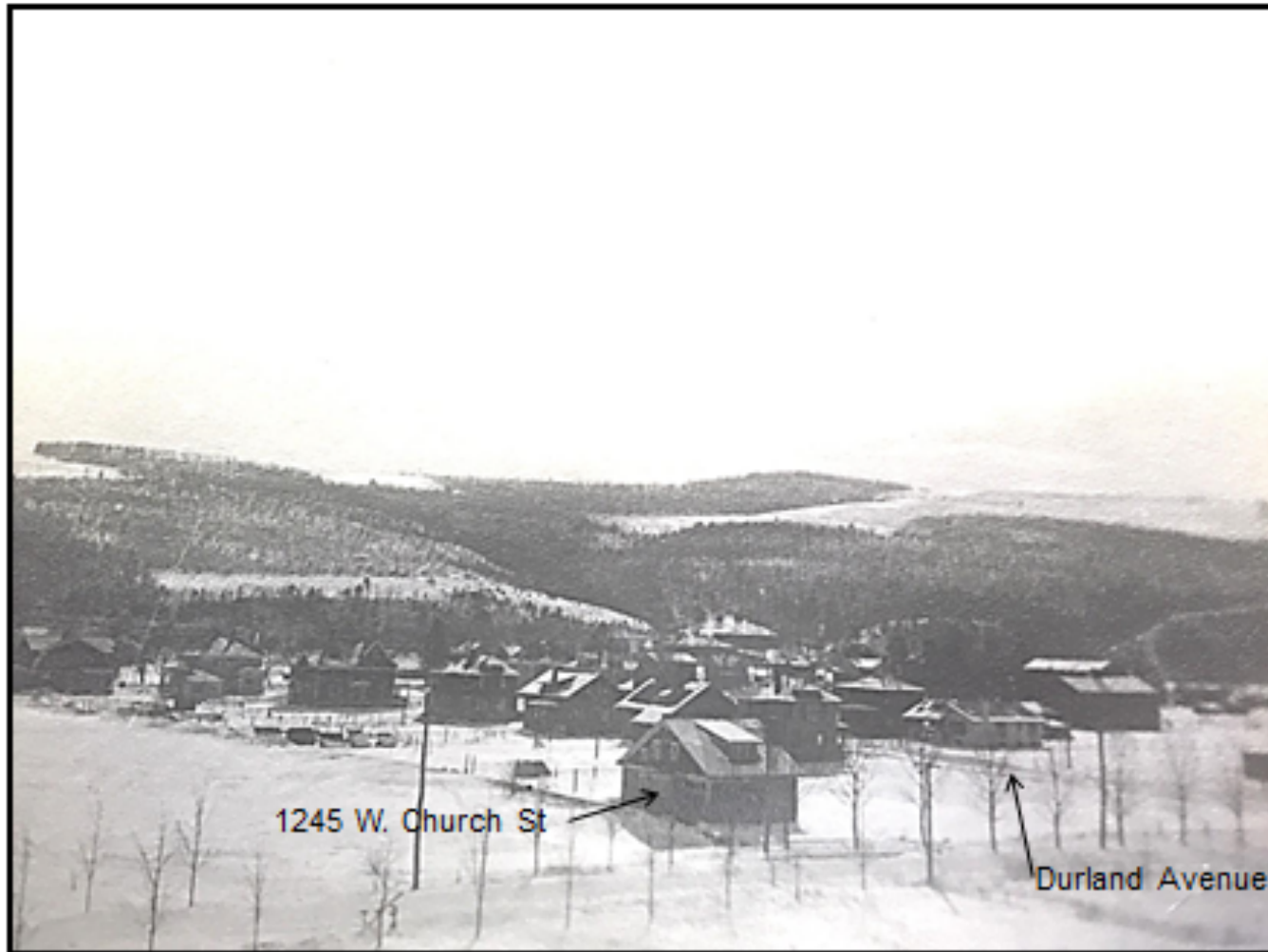
From 1237 W. First Street looking South East towards Underwood and Lexington Avenues



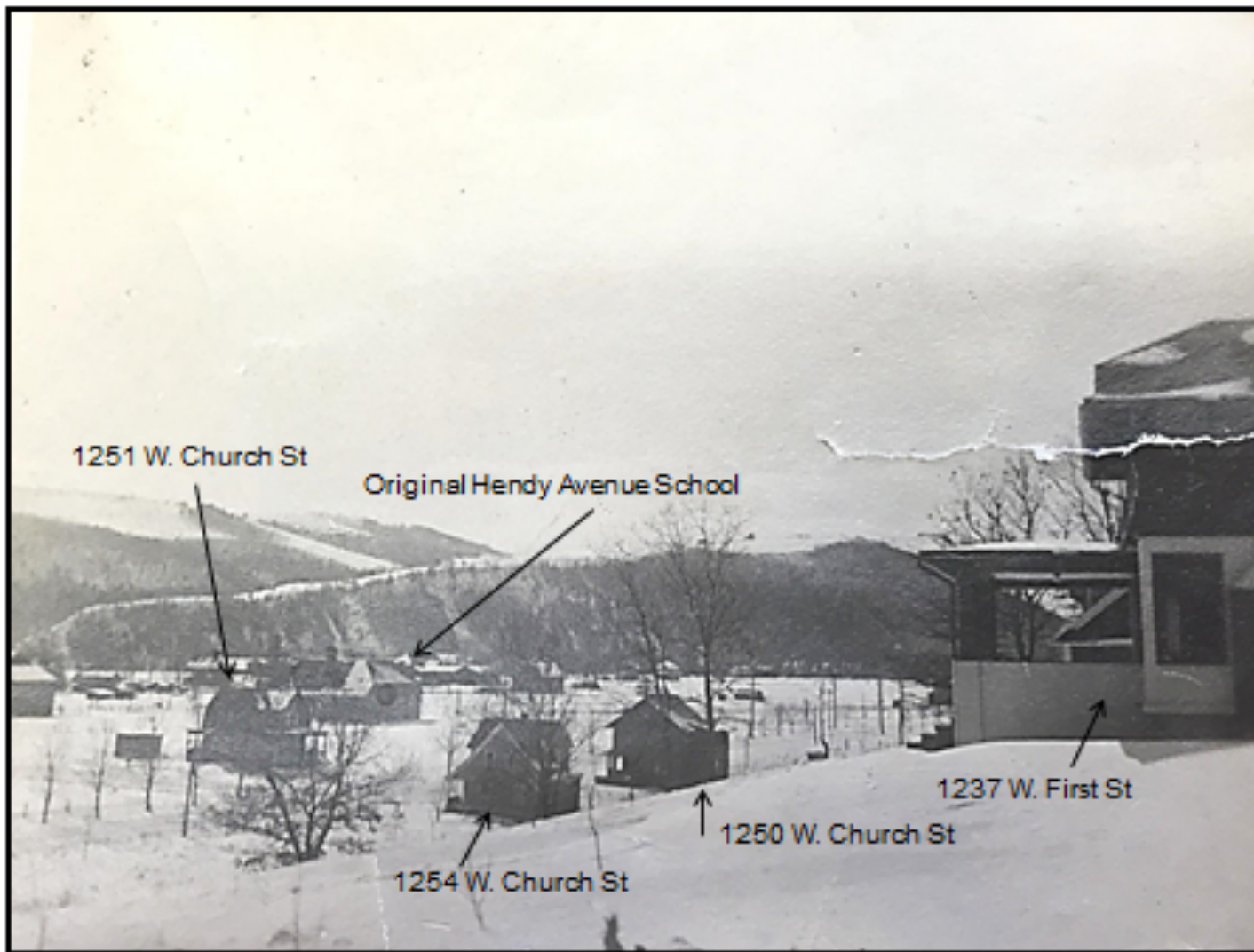
