Chairman Sullivan mentions the recent court case from the New York State Appellate Division regarding solar companies being recognized as a Public Utility and that public utilities have a less stringent burden when seeking a variance. It is noted that applicants seeking a use variance must prove unnecessary hardship through four statutory criteria. The public utility test only has to satisfy that, 1.) the relief is a public necessity and; 2.) Compelling reasons make it more feasible to seek the variance rather than pursue an alternative location.

Attorney Moore states that the referenced case law could have an impact on this board at some point considering the influx in renewable energy applications the Town has received.

Chairman Sullivan asks if there is any other business up for discussion and hearing none asks for a motion to adjourn.
